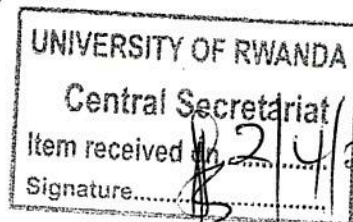

Dear Vice Chancellor,

RE: Regularization of the PhD by Research Programmes at the University of Rwanda

Reference is made to the merger of the previous seven (7) Public Institutions into a single University, the University of Rwanda, which included integration and harmonization of academic programmes that were offered by the previous institutions.

Reference is made to your application for Regularization of PhD by Research Programmes at the University of Rwanda, including those that were inherited from the former National University of Rwanda (NUR) and established by University of Rwanda (UR).

The Higher Education Council (HEC) conducted an assessment of UR's application for regularization of the PhD by Research from 04 - 08/02/2019 and assessed the following: i) UR's Framework and Regulations for Higher Degrees by Research compliance with the established National and Regional Guidelines for Higher Degrees; ii) UR's compliance with the established Framework and Regulations; iii) Availability of infrastructure and facilities required to support the PhD by Research programmes, and iv) Students support.

The findings of the assessment indicate that the University of Rwanda has not only made efforts to inherit seventy four (74) PhD by Research programmes from the former National University of Rwanda, as a result of the merger and academic integration of the previous public institutions of higher learning into UR, but also established sixteen (16) PhD by Research programmes in line with the university's mandate of teaching at all levels of the higher education, and aligned to roles of a higher education institution such as the University of Rwanda to produce human resource with the requisite skills for the development of the nation.

I am therefore delighted to inform you that your application for Regularization of ninety (90) PhD by Research programmes at the University of Rwanda leading to ninety seven (97) different Doctoral Awards **is approved** (list of the approved PhD by Research Programmes is annexed to the report). The detailed report of the assessment with recommendations is attached to this letter. HEC will follow up the implementation of these recommendations.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. The University of Rwanda (UR) is a public institution established by the Government of Rwanda through law N^o. 71/2013 of 10/09/2013. It resulted from the merger and integration of seven (07) public higher learning institutions (HLIs) that were consolidated into a single public university. The previous seven (07) public institutions were: the National University of Rwanda (NUR), the Kigali Institute of Science and Technology (KIST), the Kigali Institute of Education (KIE), the Institute of Agriculture and Animal Husbandry (ISAE), the Kigali Health Institute (KHI), the School of Finance and Banking (SFB) and the UMUTARA Polytechnic (UP). The merger and integration of the former seven (7) public institutions of higher learning resulted in the University of Rwanda with the following six (6) constituent colleges: College of Arts and Social Sciences (CASS); College of Business and Economics (CBE); College of Agriculture, Animal Sciences and Veterinary Medicine (CAVM); College of Education (CE); College of Medicine and Health Sciences (CMHS), and College of Science and Technology (CST).

2. The consolidation of the seven (7) public institutions into a single university, the University of Rwanda, included integration and harmonization of academic programmes that were offered by the previous institutions. This included the University of Rwanda inheriting a total of seventy four (74) PhD by Research Programmes that were offered by the former National University of Rwanda (NUR). In addition to inheriting 74 PhD by Research programmes from the former NUR, the University of Rwanda inherited from the NUR Framework and Regulations for Higher Degrees by Research and Regulations on Cheating and Plagiarism in Research Degrees.

3. The University of Rwanda has established sixteen (16) PhD by Research programmes since its establishment, making a total of 90 PhD by Research programmes (74 inherited from NUR and 16 established by UR) leading to 97 different awards of Doctor of Philosophy with a total of 222 enrolled students, hosted/offered in the Centers and Schools of the six constituent Colleges of the University of Rwanda. In addition to the PhD by Research programmes, the University of Rwanda has nine (09) PhD Programmes by Coursework that have been accredited by the Higher Education Council.

4. The Assessment Team was assigned to assess the UR's application for regularization of the PhD by Research programmes in terms of the following aspects: i). The extent to which UR's Framework and Regulations for Higher Degrees by Research comply with the established national and regional guidelines; ii). The UR's compliance with established Framework and Regulations; iii). Availability of infrastructure and facilities required to support the PhD by Research programmes, and iv). Students support.

5.0 Conclusions and Recommendations

5.1. Conclusions

Based on the assessment findings on the extent to which the PhD by Research programmes at the University of Rwanda, both by the former National University of Rwanda and the University of Rwanda, were established in compliance with the Higher Education Council's Framework and Regulations for Higher Degrees the University of Rwanda's Framework and Regulations, the availability of infrastructure and facilities required to support the PhD by Research programmes, the Assessment Team recommends that the University of Rwanda's application for
